RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR REGISTRATIONS

- The competition will be conducted in an online format in consideration of prevailing national circumstances. All participants are expected to ensure stable internet connectivity throughout the duration of the event.
- Each participating school is permitted to register a maximum of two teams. Each team must consist of five members, and no substitutions will be allowed once registration has been finalized.
- The official date of the event will be communicated in due course. The competition is provisionally scheduled to commence at 6:00 p.m. and conclude at 6:00 a.m. the following day.
- The detailed structure, format, and progression of the quiz competition will be announced prior to the event. Participants are advised to stay updated through official communication channels.
- It is mandatory that all registration details, including names and institutional affiliations, are submitted accurately. The information provided in the registration form will be used for all official documentation, including certificates.
- Participants must have access to a functional laptop or desktop device with functional cameras and microphones capable of supporting the required online platforms. Devices should be installed with the following apps.
 - ZOOM
 - Google Chrome
 - Microsoft Edge
- The use of such a device is strongly recommended to ensure optimal participation and to avoid technical limitations.
- The email address provided at the time of registration must be valid, active, and accessible. This email will serve as the primary mode of communication and may function as a **unique identifier** or **access key** for participation in the quiz. Participants are therefore advised to ensure accuracy and regular monitoring of the submitted email address.

- A subject selected by one participant should not be selected by another.
- All teams are expected to maintain academic integrity and adhere to the rules of fair competition. Any form of misconduct, including unauthorized collaboration or the use of prohibited resources, may result in disqualification.
- The deadline for registration is set for 1st May. All entries must be submitted on or before this date, as late submissions will not be considered.
